The Minister will consider comments received on or before **Friday September 26, 2008**. The final regulation is at the discretion of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

This may involve disclosing materials or comments, or summaries of them, to other interested parties during and after the request for public comment process.

An individual who provides materials or comments and who indicates an affiliation with an organization will be considered to have submitted those comments or materials on behalf of the organization so identified.
